

# Gas-O-Lator manual

## Caution

- This can be a dangerous process and should only be done in a well-vented area, away from sparks and open flames.
- Wear safety glasses.
- Use common sense.
- You have to be over 18 years of age.

## Choosing gas

To extract THC you can use two kinds of butane. Isobutane (2-methyl-Propane) is cheaper, but more toxic than n-butane, which is the cleanest and least toxic. To get an indication of the quality of the gas you want to use, it is recommended to perform a mirror test:

Spray the gas on a clean glass or mirror, wait 3 minutes while the gas evaporates. If the gas is high quality, it will not leave any residue.

## The extraction process

You will need either a large Pyrex tray or a large mirror, and one or two bottles of butane. Check the table below to get an indication of how much gas you'll need.

charge	Quality	amount of gas	harvest
25 grms	first quality buds	600 ml	3 to 5 grms
25 grms	medium quality buds	500 ml	3 to 4 grms
26 grms	low quality buds	450 ml	2 to 3 grms
27 grms	high quality leaf material	500 ml	2 to 3 grms
28 grms	medium quality leaf material	400 ml	1 to 2 grms
29 grms	low quality leaf material	300 ml	0 to 1 grms

Before proceeding to the next steps, take notice of the following **safety instructions**:

- Do not smoke while extracting.
- Do not extract near any open flames, e.g. hot water tank, furnace, etc.
- Do not remove the butane can from the Gas-O-Lator until 30 seconds after the can is empty.
- Do not directly inhale fumes.
- Do not wear loose sweaters or bulky clothing during extraction.

Directions:

- 1) Put on safety glasses
- 2) Grind dry herb to dust, then loosely place it in the Gas-O-Lator.
- 3) Place filter inside of cap. Screw cap back on Gas-O-Lator snug.
- 4) Go to a ventilated area with no open flame or smoking within 150'.
- 5) Hold single hole up and place butane tip in and release butane through unit.
- 6) Butane sprays through unit onto mirror or in Pyrex tray.
- 7) Do not remove butane can until 30 seconds after the can is empty.
- 8) Wait 24 hours and your extract is ready, on the Pyrex tray or mirror.
